FINANCE COMMITTEE

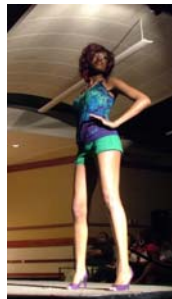
The Finance Committee is charged with raising and appropriating funds for events organized by the BCC.

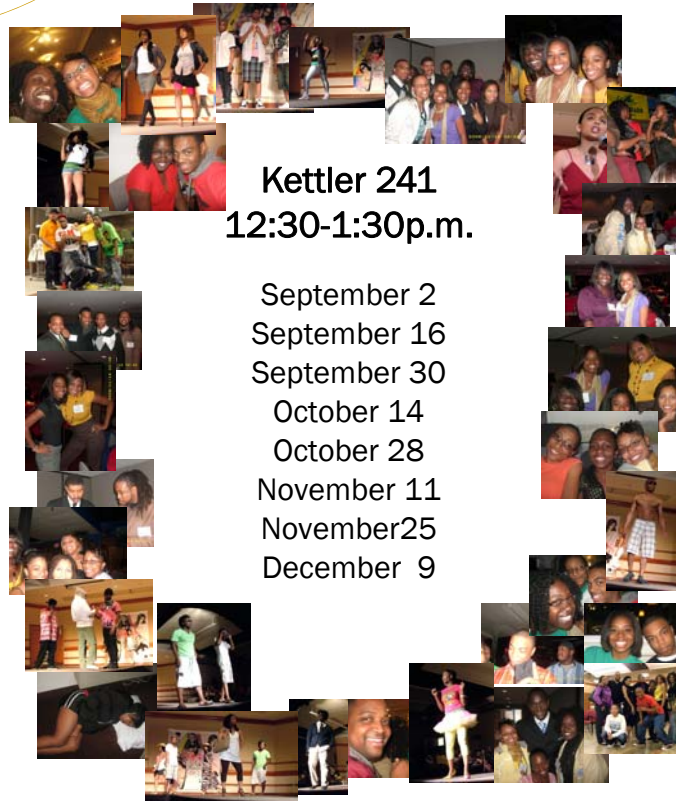
